Tennessee 4-H encourages diverse groups of youth to develop their unique skills and talents to the fullest potential. Young people participate in 4-H through clubs, special interest groups, after-school programs, camps and many other activities. "Learning by doing: through hands-on activities and community involvement empowers 4-Hers to develop and strengthen life skills.

## 4-H Service Project

This year, our 4-H service project will focus on supplying classroom needs at each individual school and providing playground games and equipment. This will give 4-H members an opportunity to make a difference in their individual classrooms and throughout the school. After surveying teachers, we have created a list of recommended items per grade. Students are not required to participate and are not required to bring each item listed.

**4th grade** - sidewalk chalk, crayons, kleenex, paper

**6th grade** - frisbees, pencils, hand sanitizer, colored paper

**7th grade** - nerf footballs, highlighters, disinfectant wipes, paper towels.
