<u>Clothing</u>

- Pajamas for girls size newborn to adult XL (NO GOWNS OR TANK TOPS)
- Pajamas for boys size newborn to adult XL (gym shorts and plain t-shirts will work for teens)
- Socks/Underwear all child and adult sizes

<u>Hygiene Items</u>

deodorant, toothbrush/toothpaste, body wash, shampoo, baby wash, small packages of diapers, baby wipes, feminine hygiene items (small packages)

coloring books/crayons, journal/pen, stuffed animal, blanket, fidget toys, small lego sets, bottles/sippy cups, small baby toys, backpacks/tote bags/duffle bags
