COST: \$250.00





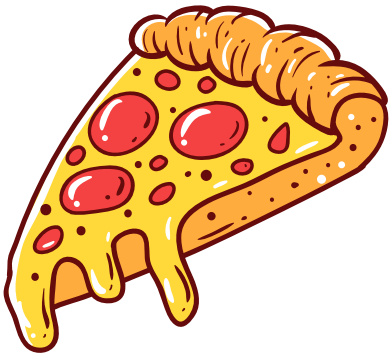
4-H Public Speaking
