



4-H Piggy Bank Contest

RULES

1. Each bank should be no larger than 12" x 12" x 12".
2. Each bank should have a place to put money in and a way to get money out without destroying the bank.
3. Each bank should be made by the youth.
4. Banks should be sturdy enough that they can be transported without coming apart or anything falling off.



JUDGING CRITERIA

1. Creativity - The contestant has used original and unique ideas in creating the bank.
2. Craftsmanship - The bank is built using neat and good quality workmanship. It will hold together while being held, transported and displayed.
3. Design - The contestant has used good principles and elements of design to make a visually appealing bank.



HOW TO ENTER

1. 4-Hers will bring their piggy bank entries to their classroom 4-H club meeting during the month of March.
2. First-place county winners will be displayed at FirstBank in Dayton. Voting will be open April 6-10, and winners will be announced on April 14.
3. Winners will advance to the State contest.
